I, INDIVIDUALLY AND AS THE VESSEL'S MASTER (IF INDEED, I AM THE VESSEL'S MASTER), MY BOAT'S OWNER OR OPERATOR, MY TEAM, THE BOAT'S CREW AND GUESTS ABOARD AGREE AND UNDERSTAND THAT THE 17TH ANNUAL SUNCOAST SERTOMA KINGFISH TOURNAMENT (SKT), ITS PARENT ORGANIZATION/FIRM OR ANY ORGANIZATION/FIRM WITH THE 17TH ANNUAL SUNCOAST SERTOMA KINGFISH TOURNAMENT (SKT) SHALL NOT BE LIABLE UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES FOR ANY INJURIES OR DAMAGES TO PERSON (S) BE THEY PHYSICAL INJURIES OR OTHERWISE, OR PROPERTY ARISING OUT OF, RESULTING FROM OR IN ANY WAY CONNECTED WITH MY/OUR/MY CREW'S PARTICIPATION IN ANY TOURNAMENT WHETHER CAUSED BY OR CONTRIBUTED TO BY ANY NEGLIGENT ACT OR NEGLIGENT OMISSION OF THE SKT OR BY ANY OTHER REASON OR CAUSE WHATSOEVER. In consideration of the acceptance of me and my team and my crew entry and for other good and valuable consideration received, we hereby remise, release and forever discharge SKT and its respective heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives, successors, assigns, parent organization/firm or any firm/organization that the SKT is part of or a division of, its/their directors, officers employees and agents of and from all claims, suits, obligations, liabilities, losses, damages, costs or expenses which our master, crew, owner(s), operator(s), team or guests aboard or their heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives, successors and/or assigns may have against SKT arisen out of, resulting from, or in any way connected with my/our participation in any tournament. We understand that this release includes any claims based upon any negligent act or negligent omissions of the SKT to the fullest extent permitted by law, individually and as the vessel's master (if, indeed, I am the vessel's master), the boat's master (if other than the boat's owner/operator), my team and the vessel's crew and guests aboard hereby agree to indemnify, to defend with counsel acceptable to the SKT and to hold the SKT and its heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives, successors, assigns, parent firm/organization or any firm/organization that the SKT is part of or a division of, its/their directors officers, employee and agents harmless from and against any and all claims, suits, obligations, liabilities, losses, damage, costs or expenses including but not limited to reasonable attorney fees suffered by the SKT by any other person or persons whatsoever (including anyone for whose acts the SKT may be liable), regardless of whether it is caused by or in part by a party indemnified and held harmless hereunder arising out of resulting from, or in any way connected with my/our participation in any tournament. All boats, owners, operators, masters, crews, guests and anglers will operate their vessels and/or fish at their own discretion and solely at their own risk. Any weather days posted or announced by the SKT will not be liable for such weather days posting or announcements or the omission of such posting or announcements. The Sertoma Club of Greater Sarasota, its principals, and its affiliates are released from all liability and damages whatsoever which may occur by virtue of competing in said tournament. I further understand that the decision to fish and participate in the Tournament is the sole responsibility of the captain/master. In consideration of Tournament accepting this registration, the registrant hereby authorizes the Tournament to use the registrant's name and/or likeness, as well as that of all crew members, free of consideration, for promotion and advertising purposes in any media form and reproduction, including, but not limited to, radio, television, newspaper, brochures and video. This agreement shall take effect as an instrument under seal and be binding upon and inure benefit of me (individually and as master of the vessel if indeed I am the master of the boat), by boat's master (if different than the owner or operator of the vessel), my team, the boat's crew and guests aboard, as well as the heirs, executors, successors and assigns of each. ## Rules and Regulations

- All entries must be turned in or mailed to the Sertoma Club of Greater Sarasota, 1618 Barber Rd., Sarasota, FL 34240
- Entry fee is \$350 per boat. Early entry fee is \$300 if received or postmarked by Monday, April 4, 2011. Tournament entry is closed at the conclusion of the mandatory captain's meeting or 9:00 PM, whichever is later. No refund of entry fees unless the tournament is cancelled by the tournament committee.
- Payment of the entry fee into a tournament constitutes a representation by each entrant that he or she has read and will abide by such rules.
- This is a captain's choice tournament. It is up to the registered captain to determine whether his or her craft is seaworthy for existing sea conditions. Participants are encouraged to scan channel 16 along with the tournament channel to keep abreast of any marine or weather warnings. The captain is responsible for all members of his crew, both on and off the water.
- We encourage everyone fishing our tournament, if not already, to become a member of SKA. You can join during the Captain's Meeting.
- The official tournament channel is VHF 68.
- All tournament boats will be issued a boat number which must be displayed throughout the tournament.
- After check out, if two or more boats come together or pass anything between boats, it will result in disqualification. The only exception is for a life-threatening emergency. The exception will apply to the boat granting assistance, not to the boat receiving assistance.
- No boat may make landfall or pass or receive anything from land after checkout or before weigh in.
- Boundaries: There are no boundaries for this tournament. You may fish anywhere in the Gulf of Mexico or its tributaries, keeping in mind the weigh in times at Marina Jack.
- Check out points will be Sarasota New Pass, Venice Jetties Stump Pass, Marina and John's Pass Bait and Charter Center.
- Check out will be from 6:45 AM to 7:15 AM. After 7:15 AM there will be a late check out until 12 noon at Marina Jack.
- No rod and reels are to be used to catch bait prior to check out.
- All fish must be caught with hand held rods and reels. No hand lines, electric reels, gigs, spears or netting allowed.
- All fish weighed in must be fit for human consumption. Please ice your fish. No mutilated or frozen fish will be accepted for weigh in. All fish weighed in become the property of the tournament and will be donated to the tournament beneficiary.
- All kingfish must be a minimum of 10 lbs. to be accepted for weigh in.
- Maximum of six anglers per boat with a maximum of six lines in use at any one time.
- In consideration of conservation, only one kingfish per boat, per category, may be weighed in.
- All tournament fish must be weighed in at Marina Jack between the hours of 3:00 PM and 5:00 PM. A certified electronic scale registering two decimal places is used and a torrmyeter may be used to check freshness. In the event of a tie, the earliest fish weighed in will be declared the winner. The weighmasters decision is final.
- All boats must have an operational 25 watt VHF radio on board.
- All boats are responsible for getting their fish to the weigh in under their own power.

## Rules and Regulations

- All tournament boats must show their number to the designated check in boat by 5:00 PM to be in the check in line. If you are not recognized by your boat number by the tournament headquarters, you will not be allowed to come to the dock and weigh your fish. The last boat in line will be handed an "end of the line" sign by the check-in boat. No boat may break in line or leave and return to the line.
- Fish will be brought to the dock by a registered angler and remain with the fish to verify the weight at the scale and sign the weigh'n slip.
- Captains and their crews are responsible for following the local, state and federal fishing and boating laws.
- Tournament committee reserves the right to refuse entry to any person.
- Any protest concerning the violation of tournament rules shall be made in writing and turned in to the tournament committee by the end of weigh'n on the day the infraction occurs. This protest must be accompanied by a \$250 cash deposit. If the protest is upheld, the \$250 will be returned, Any protest not sustained will result in the forfeit of the \$250. All decisions are final by the tournament committee.
- All entrants agree to submit to a polygraph test at the request of the tournament committee, Failure to submit to such an examination will result in disqualification from the tournament.

### Prizes and Awards

#### Overall boat prizes:

Based on 100 entries - 10 Places. For every 10 entries over 100, one place will be added. Maximum of 20 places. The largest kingfish (by weight) caught during the tournament will win \$10,000. The next nine places will consist of cash and merchandise. The remainder of places paid will consist of cash only. No boat can win more than one overall prize.

#### 23 and under Division:

First Place \$1000. Second Place \$500. Third Place \$250.

#### Ladies Division

Three places consisting of merchandise only.

#### Youth Division:

Three places consisting of merchandise only.

#### Resident Bonus Prize:

The largest fish weighed in by a Sarasota or Manatee County resident wins a \$1,000.00 Bonus Prize
